General Description

The Cornerstone Woodlake EPC Church is opening a summer position for a youth intern who will assist in the church's ministry to youth and children. This job will be 15 hours a week for 10 weeks. This year special emphasis is needed in outreach to the community's youth. Compensation will be \$250 per week, \$2500 for the summer.

Supervision

The primary supervisors will be the Christian Ed. director and the Christian Ed. elder with whom regular meetings will be held for prayer, planning, evaluation, and support. The intern will also work with the current youth ministry volunteers utilizing them as advisors, assistants, teachers, chaperones, etc.

Duties:

Youth

1. Plan and execute weekly Youth Group (7th - 12th) meetings: small group Bible Studies, Wed. Family Swim and Fellowship Nights, etc.
2. Work with supervisors in planning and executing social events, retreats, and special trips.
3. Develop discipling relationships with youth by spending individual time.
4. Attend summer camp as a counselor if needed.
5. Plan and participate with the youth in a mission experience, i.e. a week at Gleanings for the Hungry.

Christian Ed

1. Participate in 1 week Summer Day Camp (VBS)
2. Attend any scheduled Christian Ed Committee mtgs. to give support and overall encouragement to educational ministry.

General Church

1. Attend and occasionally participate in Sunday Worship.
2. Support church events.

Personal Growth

1. Spend time daily in studying God's WORD and prayer.
2. Have a regular day off.
3. Belong to a small group of adults (peers) and study, pray, and worship together.
